- I find this fee to be reasonable pursuant to Castellanos v. Next Door Co., 192 So. 2d 431 (Fla. 2016).

- 3. Accordingly, the Stipulation is approved and is contingent upon the contemporaneous approval of the Motion for Approval of Attorney's Fees and Allocation of Child Support Arrearage for Settlement under §440.20(11)(c) for overall settlement of this claim.
- 4. Pursuant to the stipulations of the parties, the E/C shall have thirty (30) days from the date of this Order during which to make such payment to Charles Leo, Esquire.
